Sir,

“DON'T MESS WITH OUR CALCUTTA” which heads on Tuesday's Telegraph was very much appropriate and appreciable in the current tune. A bit to add to it will be “.... AND THE CITIZENS”

In view with this, may I request you to allow me to present my observation on the background responsible for this kind of tragedy?. To understand it in a better way we have to look back into the past experiences which happened in our state since SINGUR, later on the same incident was experimented at NANDIGRAM, its recapture by “*Our People*” under the “*New Rising Sun*”, then the RIZWANUR MURDER CASE, NANDARAM MARKET FIRE, and the present BIRD FLU epidemic which proves that the state has failed in providing the minimum constitutional remedial measures to its citizens.
